### **Behrend Academic Requirements**

- Two college level Mathematics courses (PSYCH 200, CMPSC 203, and PHIL 012 do **not** meet this requirement)
- CHMPD 451: General Biochemistry
- PSYCH 100: Psychology (*offered every semester*)

*Complete the following course with a grade of "B" or better:*

- HD FS 129: Human Development and Family Studies  
OR  
PSYCH 212: Developmental Psychology (Prerequisite is PSYCH 100)

*Complete the following courses either at Behrend or Mercyhurst College:*

- EDPSY 014: Learning and Instruction (concurrent with 1 credit of C I 295)
- EDTHP 115: Education in American Society (concurrent with 1 credit of C I 295)

## **Mercyhurst College Fifth-Year Requirements**

- EDUC 201: Social Foundations of Education (If EDTHP 115 was not taken at Behrend)
- EDUC 300: General Methods of Secondary Education
- EDUC 302: Educational Psychology (If EDPSY 014 was not taken at Behrend)

- EDUC 475: A Full-Time Twelve-Week Student Teaching Experience
