Behrend Academic Requirements

Complete the following courses with a grade of "C" or better:

- One college-level Literature course
- Two college-level Mathematics course [PSYCH 200, CMPSC 203(GQ), and PHIL 012(GQ) do **not** meet this requirement]
- One biological science with accompanying lab course (such as BIOL 011/012 or BIOL 110S)
- Any computer course (such as CMPSC 203, CSE 121, etc.)
- COMMU 317: Communication for Teachers and Trainers (*offered Spring only*)
- EDPSY 014: Learning and Instruction (concurrent with 1 credit of C I 295; *offered once a year*)
- EDTHP 115: Education in American Society (concurrent with 1 credit of C I 295; *offered once a year*)
- ELISH 481: Teaching Children's Literature (*offered every other Spring*)
- GEOG 010: Physical Geography (*offered every semester*)
- PL SC 001: Introduction to American National Government (*offered every semester*)
- PSYCH 100: Psychology (*offered every semester*)

Complete the following course with a grade of "B" or better:

- HD FS 129: Human Development and Family Studies (*offered every semester*)
OR
PSYCH 212: Developmental Psychology (Prerequisite is PSYCH 100; *offered Fall only*)
