## MICHAEL JUDE WOODS '76

Michael Jude Woods '76 is president and CEO of Telesource Services, LLC, a worldwide leader in the remanufacture, repair, and resale of digital telecommunications equipment, cellular phones, and laptop computers.



Mr. Woods established Telesource in 1986, and today the company has grown to include three divisions: voice networks, data networks, and laptop repair services. Last year the company's 250 employees reached \$32 million in annual sales. Telesource is headquartered in Pontiac, Michigan, but maintains offices and production centers in Chicago, Illinois, and Costa Mesa, California. Although the company's primary market is North America, it also provides products and services in fourteen other countries.

Mr. Woods has served on the boards of the Michigan Humane Society and the Detroit Zoo. He is a director of the Young President's Organization, a member of the advisory board of CEO Clubs of America, and past president and chair of the North American Association of Telecommunication Dealers. He is also active in Republican politics.

Mr. Woods received a bachelor's degree in psychology from Penn State Erie in 1976. During his senior year he was president of the Student Government Association and recipient of the Thomas H. Turnbull Award for outstanding service to the college community. He is a life member of the Penn State Alumni Association and a member of Penn State's President's Club.

A highly successful and innovative entrepreneur himself, Mr. Woods is a member of Penn State Behrend's Entrepreneurship Advisory Board, which encourages and advises students in developing viable business plans. Mr. Woods and his wife, Tracy Kimes Woods, and their daughter, Elizabeth, reside in Orchard Lake Village, Michigan.
