Registration with payment is required at least one week prior to class start date. **REGISTER EARLY—classes have limited enrollment and fill quickly!** Please register each child separately. If you do not have access to our online registration, you may photocopy the registration form or get additional forms by calling Continuing Education at 898-6103. Online registration is available at behrend.psu.edu/kids. Registration is not complete until all applicable forms have been completed and payment has been received. Some fees may be tax-deductible as child-care expenses according to IRS regulations. Please consult with your accountant.

Payment Options

Accepted forms of payment are VISA, MasterCard, Discover, and American Express credit cards, cash, personal checks, and money orders made payable to The Pennsylvania State University.

Cancellation Policy

If for any reason a parent must cancel a child's class registration, the cancellation must be received in writing fourteen days in advance of the class. The cancellation will be processed by Penn State and a refund will be available to the parent in approximately four weeks. If payment was made by credit card a refund will be made within seven working days. If a cancellation is requested after the class begins a refund cannot be made. If the parent cancels within the fourteen-day period a \$25 fee will be assessed.

Program Expectations

Children are expected to be respectful and courteous to one another and all staff members. Disruptive behavior such as hitting, biting, and name-calling or destruction of property will not be tolerated. Disruptive behavior will be handled as follows:

Day 1: Warning and discussion with student. **Day 2:** Parent discussion. **Day 3:** Student will be withdrawn from the program.

Drop-off and Pick-up

Drop-off and pick-up is located in the Reed Union Building Wintergarden. Short-term parking is available in the Reed Union Building parking lot. Parents remaining on campus should see Police Services for a parking permit. Students not using Early/Late Care may be dropped off no more than fifteen minutes before the start of class and should be picked up immediately at the end of class. If a student needs to be dropped off or picked up during class time, call Continuing Education at 898-6103 to make arrangements. **Penn State Behrend provides a secure drop-off and pick-up area for your child's safety. Parents are required to present a photo ID when signing their children out each day. NO EXCEPTIONS!**

Lunch and Snack Breaks

Children will be provided with one break during class. Children are encouraged to bring a snack and drink with them. An opportunity may be provided to purchase snack items at the bookstore or vending machines. If your child is attending camp all day, the program will supervise the lunch hour at no additional charge. Lunch is not provided by the program. Children are expected to bring a packed lunch, or they may purchase food items from Bruno's Café, the college eatery.
